Therefore the project will offer free training to those who cannot afford tertiary education otherwise due to lack of fees, lack of minimum qualification to continue with higher education and any other social or cultural reason.

Training is to be offered in the fields of agriculture, energy, technology, mechanics and many others. KIITEC participated in this program by recruit-

ing hundreds of applicants in the limited time given. The sponsorship will afford successful candidates a year of free training in a course of their choosing in any of the institutions appointed by the World Bank.

KIITEC will offer training in Domestic Electrical and Solar PV Systems Installation and in IT & Security Course among others, to candidates who qualify for the sponsorship program. It will be noted that for the past thirteen years KIITEC has been offering semi and / or full sponsorships to qualifying students as an endeavor to fight poverty in Tanzania and by training sustainable technicians; many of whom are employed, or self-employed.
